



TABI Artificial Intelligence Policy

January 2025

Purpose: To address the identification of tarot decks, and other tarot-related materials, created using Artificial Intelligence (AI) when highlighted, spotlighted, or otherwise mentioned on the TABI website, TABI forums, TABI social media platforms, workshops, or conferences. Specific direction below as this applies to the TABI CARTA Awards, beginning in 2025.

Historical Information: With the rapid influx of AI created art, both visual graphics and written, it has become necessary to address these materials from the standpoint of transparency, and to disclose the use of AI in the interest of fairness for TABI members, and the artists, authors, and creators we support.

- All decks created, either wholly or in part by using AI technology must be identified as such when shared across all TABI platforms, preferably with additional information stating the reason for using AI, the extent of AI vs. human creation, and the source.
- CARTA will allow AI created deck entries for submission in the annual awards, provided the above requirement is met.
- AI books, guidebooks, or other written materials will not be accepted for submission.
- Any creator (et al) who does not properly identify AI use in their CARTA submission will be immediately disqualified. Entry fees will not be refunded and any potential awards, if identified after the fact, will be rescinded and awarded to the first runner-up.
